**Guided Film
Discussion(K-8)**

Students form small groups to discuss the film using pre-written questions. The class will then come together to make a poster on daily actions they will take to become better Tree Tenders.

Socratic Seminar (8-16)

Students lead the discussion by creating their own in-depth questions and will discuss amongst their peers, practicing polite, intelligent debate skills.

Team Tree Tender (6-16)

Groups of 3-4 students will report on a chosen ecosystem service, highlighting how we benefit, how we've affected it, and how we can help restore it. Allows students to practice collaborating, presenting, and reporting on current events.

Matching Game (K-8)**

A quick, fun, traditional matching game, but students will be matching a human-caused environmental issue to a solution. When they make a match, more advanced students will come up with a second solution.

Go Extinct! (All Ages)

A three-part game where students are given an organism to represent, and through active movement and collaboration, students will understand the connection between organisms, the presence of a common ancestor, and the effect we have on the planet.
